

Life in the Forest

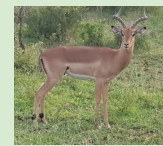
The predator is praying for the prey

So they can eat and eat, not go hungry.

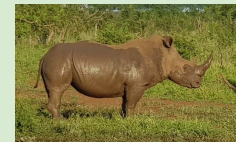


Some are food for others
