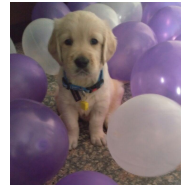
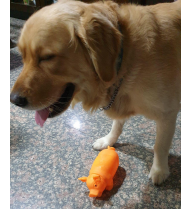


## Our Loving Veeru

Having him, brought us a bundle of joy.



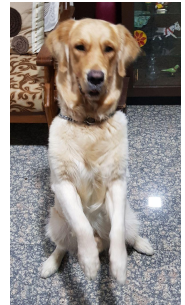
He gives so much love, which is unconditional

Eat, sleep, bark and be playful.



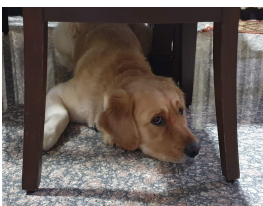
Taking him for a walk you need strong shoulders
