

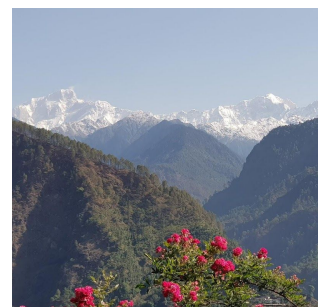
## The Char Dham Yatra

The lifeline for millions of citizens.

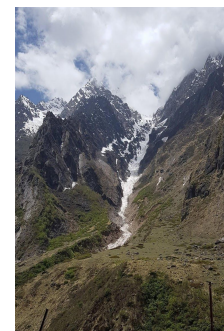


You see the beauty of the nature
